<u>Analysis:</u> Reading and writing results are the highest for 3 years and maths for 2 years. Reading, Writing and Maths are above National figures and combined is significantly above. Interventions, which we are now calling adaptations show:

- > Out of the 6 girls targeted for maths, all 6 achieved expected 100%.
- Out of the 8 children who attended the GDS session at Hurst, 6 children achieved GDS 75% all of the 4 girls who attended achieved GDS.
- > Out of the 5 children in the reading booster, 5 achieved expected standard.
- > The cohort had 3 PP children, all of which had SEND. I child achieved Reading Expected. All 3 of the PP / SEND children made significant progress from their starting points.

Next Steps: Look at maths data, in particular problem solving and target this area.
