Analysis:

EYFS: ELG this year is 12% higher this year compared to last year: 2023 58% 2024 70% 68%.

Word Reading has improved this year 2023-24 with 91% compared to 2022-3, 73%.

Maths Number had improved this year: 2023 65% 2024 83%.

Next Steps: Adaptations for children who are working below specific prime areas.

Phonics: Phonics results for the last 2 years have been above National: 2022-23 83% 79% 2023-24 81% 80% with 1 child disapplied 85%. Out of the 12 children who had targeted intervention 11 passed – 92%, with 1 child going from 4 to 29. In Y2, the PP & SEND pupil went from a score of 0 in Y1 to 20 in Y2.

Next Steps: Early adaptations in Y1 for the children in YR who have not met phonic targets.
